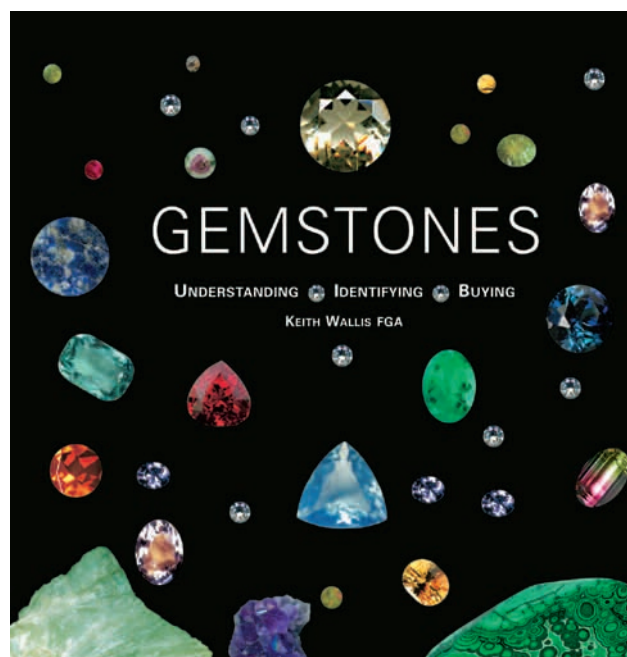

Author Keith Wallis, a qualified gemmologist, is a firm believer in demystifying the complexities of the world of gemstones. He began his working life studying architecture, later moving

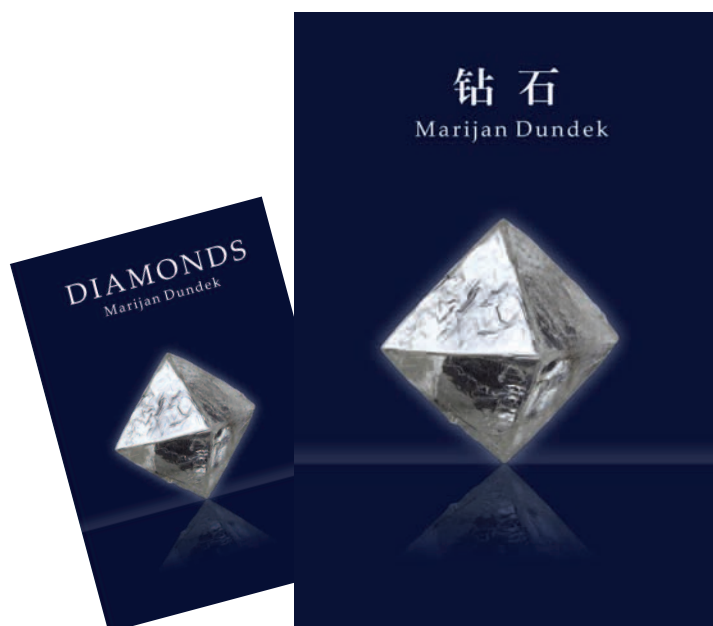
